She holds several honours and awards, including: the International Association of Applied Psychology Award for Distinguished Scientific Contributions (1998), the International Association for Cross-Cultural Psychology Honorary Fellow (1998) and the American Psychological Association Distinguished Contributions to the International Advancement of Psychology Award (1993). She is involved in theoretical and applied work with family, parenting, early childhood and human development in cultural context and has directed several research projects. Her recent publication is 'Family, Self and Human Development Across Cultures: Theory and Applications' (Revised Second Edition) with Lawrence Erlbaum (2007).
