His expertise includes meta-analysis, child development, parent education and early childhood education. His main research topic is 'parenting and its influence on children's attachments and stress regulation'. Marinus H. van IJzendoorn is elected member of the Royal Dutch Academy of Arts and Sciences and an honorary doctor of the University of Haifa. He was awarded by the Society for Research in Child Development (2007) and received the Spinoza Prize of the Netherlands Organization for Scientific Research (2004). His special keynotes were the Kohlberg Memorial Lecture at the 35th Annual Conference of the Association for Moral Education (2009), the Emanuel Miller Memorial Lecture of the Association for Child and Adolescent Mental Health (2006) and the Winnicott Lecture at the national meeting of the Australian Association for Infant Mental Health (1997).
